Designer's maximalist Soho loft seeks \$10M

Stylist and designer Lori Goldstein bought the apartment at 10 Sullivan last year

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Closings only began last year at 10 Sullivan, the Cary Tamarkin-designed condo that towers over Soho, but one of its apartments—and a very colorful one at that—is already back on the market. Designer and stylist Lori Goldstein, whose work can be seen in *Vogue, Vanity Fair*, and plenty of other high-end places, listed her fifth-floor pad, which she purchased in 2016, for \$10 million.

Goldstein's <u>website</u> explains that her credo is "everything goes with anything," which is a philosophy that apparently extends to her living spaces, too. "Maximalist" is an understatement here, with the decor spanning various design styles and eras.

As for the apartment itself, it's a three-bedroom, two-bathroom space, and it comes with not one, but two terraces totaling around 1,300 square feet.
